

Permit Prices:

- **€30 / day**, under 15-year-olds **€15 / day**.

Fishing Rules:

- Fishing is permitted only within the **area marked on the map**.
- There is **no fisherman quota**.
- Lure fishing and fly fishing are **permitted methods of fishing**.
- The use of a **knotless mesh** landing net is recommended.
- The use of a **gaff** is prohibited.
- Only **barbless hooks** are permitted. Either **one barbless treble hook** or **two barbless single hooks**.
- Fishing from an **anchored boat** is prohibited.
- Anglers fishing from the shore have **priority**.
- **Reserving a fishing spot** is prohibited. If another fisherman is waiting for their turn, the angler must give way after **15 minutes**.
- Fishing will be suspended when the water temperature exceeds **+22°C**. Permits can be cancelled with a **two-day notice**. Cancellations will be notified via email.
- **Catch report is mandatory**. The easiest way to submit a catch report is via the QR code link on the guide signs or here: [catch report](#).

Minimum Sizes and Catch Limits:

- **Wild trout** (with an adipose fin) is strictly protected at all times.
- The allowable size limit for **fin-clipped trout** (hatchery-reared) is **60 – 70 cm**. The quota per fisherman is **one fin-clipped trout / permit**.
- The minimum size limit for **grayling** is **45 cm**. The quota per fisherman is **one grayling / permit**.
- **Rainbow trout**: no minimum size limit, no catch limit. There may be rainbow trout in the Tainionvirta stream from stockings in previous years and from upstream waters.
- **Whitefish**: no minimum size limit, no catch limits.
- **Zander**: the minimum size limit is **42 cm**. No catch limits.
- **Perch**: no minimum size limit, no catch limits.
- **Pike**: no minimum size limit, no catch limits. Bream and ide are also found in the stream; no minimum size limit, no catch limits.
